Entry

Entry is by koha. A koha is a reciprocal contribution recognising that we are sharing our home with you. We have been asked for guidance - most people contribute \$15-20 per adult.

Guided tours


Guided tours are available at \$35 per adult, by prior arrangement. People who have been on a tour may also explore freely afterwards.
