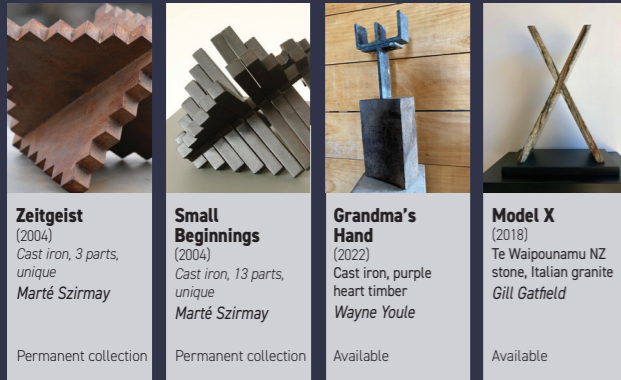

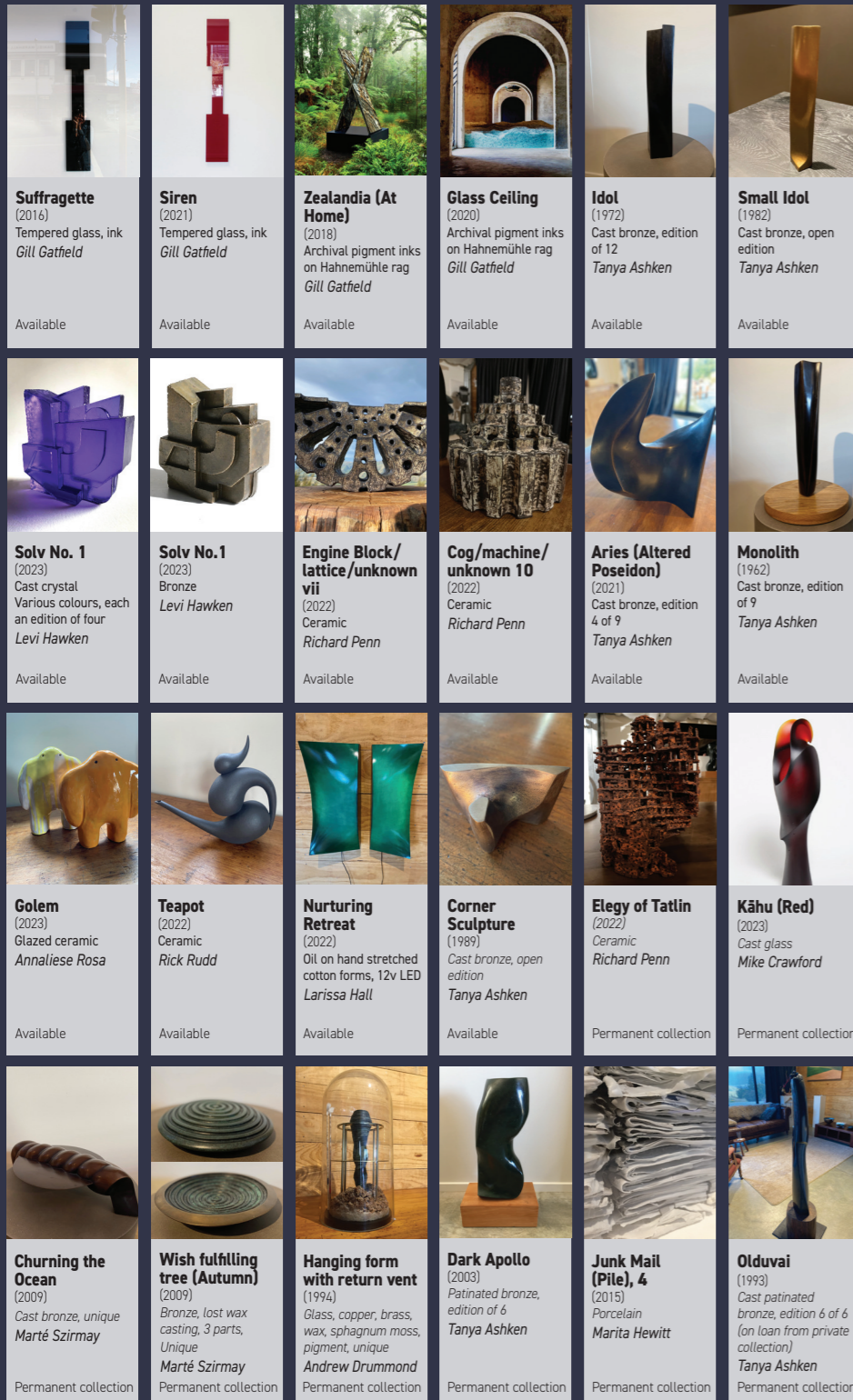

Through our artists residency, sculptors can take time out to connect with our unique environment, refresh perspectives and be inspired.

Purchasing artworks

Works for sale are indicated in the catalogue. Payment must be made in full before works can be uplifted at the end of the show period. Packing, insurance and transport is the responsibility of the purchaser, but we can provide advice and put you in touch with a local installer for Central Otago installations. Installation is at the purchaser's expense and will vary according to the work and the site.

Commissions

We can arrange commissions, editions and source other works by the artists on show.

Entry

Entry is by koha. A koha is a reciprocal contribution recognising that we are sharing our home with you. We have been asked for guidance – most people contribute \$15-20 per adult.

Guided tours

Guided tours are available at \$35 per adult, by prior arrangement. People who have been on a tour may also explore freely afterwards.

Health and safety

Children must be closely supervised at all times. The ground is sloping and uneven in places. Only suitable for all terrain buggies. Remain within the fenceline. This property is smokefree due to fire hazard. Do not climb on sculptures or attempt to touch kinetic works. Do not enter roped off areas. Keep well hydrated in summer and warm in other seasons.

We can provide fresh masks and hand sanitiser, but please do not visit if you are unwell. We acknowledge your koha and thank you for respecting our tikanga.

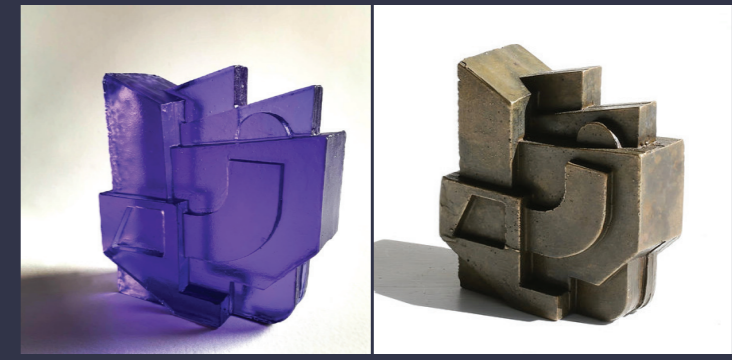
